



## POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

### **Position**      **Part-time Instructors (Gateway to College- Savannah & Effingham Campuses -Grant Funded)**

Savannah Technical College is seeking part-time instructors in Mathematics for Gateway to College, a program serving at-risk youth, 16-20 years old, who have dropped out of school or who are at risk of dropping out. These instructors are responsible for providing appropriate learning experiences and educational opportunities for each student assigned to the classroom. These instructors must display a high level of effort and commitment to performing work assignments, operate effectively within the organizational structure, and demonstrate trustworthiness and responsible behavior. Duties include: providing instruction, assessing and encouraging student progress, managing the learning environment, meeting frequently with Gateway to College staff, and other duties as required based on the specific content area taught (such as content-area competitions, after-hours activities, and so on). These instructors should follow professional practices consistent with college and district policies in working with students, students' records, parents, and colleagues. These instructors will attend and participate in assigned meetings and activities related to Gateway to College. These instructors may sit on the Gateway to College Board of Directors. These positions require the ability to teach both day and evening classes. **Instructors are sought for both Savannah and Effingham campuses.** These instructors report to the Director of Gateway to College.

### **Minimum Qualifications**

Bachelors degree from an accredited college or university; Valid Georgia teaching certificate in the required field – English 6-12, Reading 6-12, or Mathematics 6-12.

### **Preferred Qualifications**

In addition to the minimum qualifications: prior experience and passion for working with at-risk student populations; prior experience teaching in a college environment; strong classroom management skills.

### **Physical Demands**

Work is typically performed in and classroom environment with intermittent sitting or walking in various settings. The ability to speak clearly is required. The ability to hear and understand at a normal conversational level is required. Full range of hand and finger motion is required for data entry purposes.

### **Salary/Benefits**

Salary is commensurate with education and work experience.

### **Application Deadline**

For best consideration, applications should be received by **August 3, 2009**. Position considered open until filled. Candidates must pass a criminal background check.
